Six die in herdsmen-farmers' clash

THE Pastoral Resolve said in Kaduna on Monday that six persons were killed while 600 were displaced in a herdsmen-farmers clash in Kauru Local Government Area

of Kaduna State.

The Executive Director of PARE, Dr. Saleh Momaleh, told newsmen in Kaduna that the deceased included a female and five males aged between 12 and 65 years, the News

He called on security agencies to intervene while the state government should resettle the victims.

"Only a genuine fact-finding commission can unearth the truth and bring the culprite to justice," he said.

But the Commissioner for Police, Kaduna State Command, Mr. Mohammed Tambari-Yabo, told journalists in Kaduna that three people

died in the incident.

While urging law-abiding citizens to go about their lawful businesses, Tambari-Yabo said the situation had been contained and normalcy restored.

He said some persons were helping the security agencies in their investigations.
