BREAKING NEWS: Gunmen kill The Nation correspondent



Two unidentified gunmen shot dead the Judiciary Correspondent of The Nation newspaper, Mr. Edo Ugbagwu on Saturday evening in yet to be ascertained circumstances.

Initial reports indicated that the killers stormed his residence at No 39 Church Street, Shasha, Akowonjo, a Lagos suburb at around 6.30 pm demanding money from the deceased younger brother.

The late Ugbagwu was said to have asked the gunmen to leave his apartment and was subsequently shot in the head. He died on the spot. His body has since been deposited at the Lagos University Teaching Hospital, Ikeja mortuary
