Gunmen kill three, kidnap four expatriates in A'

The spate of kidnapping continues in Akwa Ibom State as unknown **gunmen** on Friday, abducted four expatriates working with Stemco Construction Company in Essien Udim.

Three other persons including an army corporal, a policeman and a civilian, SUNDAY PUNCH gathered, lost their lives when the abductors raided the construction site where the expatriates were working.

Earlier the same day, unknown gunmen had abducted the mother of one of the governorship aspirants in the state, Chief Iniekang Udonwa.

Udonwa, who was also shot in the leg after he refused the kidnappers' entry to his Uyo residence, had been taken to an undisclosed hospital for treatment.

SUNDAY PUNCH gathered that the abductors were demanding N500m ransom before the elderly woman would

Meanwhile, Stemco's officials who were abducted include its General Manager, Site Manager and two others.

They were working on the construction of a link-bridge before the unfortunate incident happened.

The kidnappers, who disguised as if they were heading for a burial ceremony, were said to have stormed the construction site with three vehicles loaded with arms.

When contacted, the State Commissioner of Police, Mr. Walter Rigbere, confirmed the attack on the expatriates.

Rugbere also confirmed that one of the kidnappers was shot dead by the police and one was currently receiving treatment in an undisclosed hospital.

He explained that a lot of arms were recovered from the kidnappers and the police had launched a manhunt for other fleeing members of the group.

Meanwhile, the state governor, Chief Godswill Akpabio, has condemned the spate of kidnapping of innocent citizens in the state

Akpabio noted that in the last 48 hours, the state had been under the siege by criminal elements who attacked
