Two killed, five injured in road accident

Two persons were confirmed dead and five others injured in an accident involving three vehicles on Monday night on the Zion Pepe/Igbokoda Road, Okitipupa,

The Police Divisional Traffic Officer in the area, Mr. Olusegun Jegede, told the News Agency of Nigeria on Tuesday that the vehicles were a Jeep and two saloon cars.

According to him, the Jeep was coming from Igbokoda when its tyres burst at high speed.

The vehicle lost control, rammed into a Toyota Camry coming from Zion Pepe in the opposite direction.

"Seeing the accident coming his way, the driver of a Volkswagen Passat, also coming from Zion Pepe, veered to avoid them and entered the bush," Jegede said.

The police officer said the driver of the Jeep, who was unhurt, fled on seeing the magnitude of the accident and the number of casualties.

"We are still searching for the driver of the Jeep and in due course he will be found," he said.

The Chief Medical Director of the State Specialist Hospital, Okitipupa, Dr. Richard Adesoji, said two of the victims were dead on arrival.


