

Boko Haram members kill policeman in Bauchi

SUSPECTED members of the Boko Haram sect on Wednesday shot and killed a mobile policeman attached to the private residence of the Bauchi State Commissioner for Special Duties, Musa Badara, in Bauchi.

THE PUNCH learnt that the suspects invaded the commissioner's residence in the Federal Low Cost Area of the state capital around 8pm, with the intention to Badara. When they discovered that the commissioner was not at home, they shot and killed the policeman on duty.

The Commissioner of Police, Bauchi State Command, Mr. Danlami Yar'Adua, confirmed the incident on the telephone, saying the matter was being investigated.

Suspected members of the sect bombed a police station in Maiduguri on Monday. A string of attacks by members of the group in Maiduguri had left about 10 people dead in the past few weeks.
