OUR armed robbers on Tuesday stormed warehouse in Port Harcourt, the Rivers State capital, and killed

two persons. The gang, which raided the warehouse known Bonbeeco Peak Milk Depot at about 8.20am, also shot and injured the security quard on duty, Umaru Adamu.

that the hoodlums, who were armed with AK 47 rifles, had shot the deceased identified as Marcel Obinna and Onyeka at close range.

The victims were said to be customers and had arrived at the warehouse as early as 7.30am.

Both Obinna and Onveka died instantly while the security guard was rushed to the hospital after the hoodlums had left.
