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Commercial bus driver arraigned for manslaughter

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A 32-year-old commercial bus driver, Timothy Agubueze, was on Monday docked in Lagos for allegedly causing the death of one Quadri Ahmed.

Agubueze is facing a two-count charge of negligent driving and manslaughter before Magistrate, Mrs O.A. Layinka, of the Igboere Magistrates' Court in Lagos.

According to the prosecution, the offence was committed on February 22 on the Third Mainland Bridge.

It said the bus driver wrongly parked his vehicle, marked XV-505MUS in the night without consideration for other road users.

"This negligence caused the death of one Ahmed of No. 58, Aroloya Street, Lagos Island," the prosecution said.

The prosecution said that the deceased did not notice the wrongly-parked vehicle on time and ran into it.

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- If the driver is prayerfully found to be guilty, he should be dealt with within the jurisdiction of the law. No mercy for justice.
