

## Jos: Gunmen kill two in school attack By Jude Owuamanam, Jos Thursday, 31 Mar 2011 Share ☐ View All (16) Comment(s) Post Comment Send to friend Twitter Barely 72 hours to the April 2 National Assembly election, gunmen suspected to be Fulani herdsmen invaded the Federal College of Land Resources Technology in Jos for the second time in two months and killed two people in the attack. The hoodlums had on February 10, invaded the staff quarters of the school and killed five people including the Chief Security Officer, Mr. Danjuma Haruna. The latest incident occurred shortly after the son of Haruna, Gideon, raised the alarm that killers of his father were still after his life. But the younger Haruna was said to be out of the staff quarters when the Five persons were also said to have sustained injuries in the latest attack. But our our correspondent gathered that after the first incident, the police deployed four policemen in the college to guard the quarters in the night. "The sheer number of the hoodlums, who invaded the school around 9pm on Tuesday were so many that they overwhelmed the police," source said. Both the dead and the injured were taken to the Vom Christian Hospital. Sources at the scene of the incident confirmed that the attack might have been carried out by Fulani herdsmen as the scene of the killing was near the School's Livestock area. The riot policemen were said to be on the trail of the killers, a claim that could not be confirmed. The Commissioner of Police, Plateau State Command, Mr. Abdlrahman Akano, confirmed the incident. He added that the attackers were yet to be apprehended as he claimed that the attackers fled the scene after the attack. Akano also claimed that the police were on the trail of the attacker, declaring that the police would not hesitate to bring the attackers to book. NGH Election 2011 Portal


