



Mr. Aondogu Autu, was **killed** on Saturday at Tondo in Logo Local Government Area of **Benue** State during a **fracas** with a man, alleged to be a member of the Peoples Democratic Party.

The acting Police Public Relations Officer, Mr. Michael Enogela, told our correspondent on Monday that the police had arrested the suspected killer of the victim.

He also stated that the police were on the trail of two suspects said to be the masterminds of the incident that eventually culminated in the death of Abutu.

It was learnt that the late Abutu was taken to the Logo Police Division by **one** Mathias Myseniyaa, and was rushed to the hospital where he died.

Meanwhile, the Resident Electoral Commissioner of the Independent National Electoral Commission in **Benue**, Mr. Nasir Ayilara, has said that the election held without any casualty among the members of staff of the commission.

He stated, however that some results of the elections were cancelled by the commission because of observed disparities at the collation centres.

Ayilara said however that the cancellations made by the commission did not affect the April 9 election results in the state.

Also, document released to journalists at the INEC office in Makurdi on Monday showed that the Peoples Democratic Party won six out of the nine Federal Constituencies in the state, while the Action Congress of Nigeria won the remaining three.
