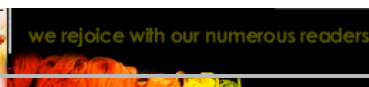

Gunmen kill monarch in Ogun

An armed gang on Friday attacked and killed a traditional ruler in Egbado North Local Government Area of Ogun State.

The traditional ruler, who until his death, was the Onijohun of Ijohun, Oba Jimoh Olubo, was allegedly killed in a private hotel at Igbogila at about 9pm on Friday.

An investigation by our correspondent showed that the murder of the oba might be connected with the recent political differences in the Ogun West Senatorial district of the state.

The Police Area Commander in Ilaro, Mr. Olusola Davies, described the killing as unfortunate.

"We have not really been able to ascertain the motive of the assassination, but I think it is an armed robbery attack," he stated.

The Police Public Relations Officer for the state command, Mr. Muiywa Adejobi, also confirmed the killing to our correspondent on Saturday.
