Two people were allegedly killed on Tuesday and four others seriously wounded during a raid by unknown persons on a Fulani settlement in Bisichi in Jos South Local Government Area of Plateau State.

Our correspondent also learnt that over 400 cows were stolen during the attack said to have been carried out between Monday night and early hours of Tuesday.

Chairman of Miyetti Allah Cattle Breeders Association of Nigeria Plateau State chapter, Alhaji Muhammad Nura, told reporters in Jos on Tuesday, that he suspected the invaders came from Shen and Du district of Jos South LGA.

He said over 40 cows had been recovered, adding that members of the association and the Special Task Force on Jos crisis had been searching for the other stolen cows.

The Media Officer of the task force, Captain Ekeocha, said he was not aware of the development.
