Three killed in Ogun

THE subdued crisis in the I Ogun State chapter of the National Union of Road Transport Workers erupted on Tuesday as no fewer than three persons were killed during a clash between rival

factions in liebu-Ode. During the clash, one Gbenga Odubona (a.k.a. Ebonyi) and two innocent persons were reportedly killed

It was learnt that the violence started about 1pm when a group of union members, armed with dangerous weapons, stormed the Epe Garage in the town, shooting indiscriminately.

It was gathered that the clash was not unconnected with the supremacy battle for the control of motor parks in liebu-Ode.

The state Police Public Relations Officer, Mr. Muviwa Adejobi, confirmed the killings, saying the police command had already commenced investigation into the incident.
