Two policemen feared dead in Delta

The onslaught on the men of the Nigeria Police Force, Delta State Command, by bandits continued on Friday evening when two policemen were killed in two separate incidents.

In the past one month, at least eight policemen have been

shot dead while on duty in the oil-rich state, sometimes in very dramatic circumstances.

Our correspondent learnt that the gunmen did not just kill the riot policeman in Friday's incident, which occurred in Warri South Local Government Area of the state, but also dispossessed him of his service rifle.

The hoodlums reportedly kidnapped an expatriate after the latter withdrew an undisclosed amount of money from a bank in Warri metropolis.

The attack took place about 48 hours after the Delta State Commissioner of Police, Mr. Mamman Tsafe, who relocated to Warri early in the week, went back to the state headquarters in Asaba.

Police Public Relations Officer in the state, Mr. Charles Muka, confirmed the incident and said the police were on the trail of the suspects.

The second policeman was killed when two Hausa/Fulani herdsmen allegedly stabbed him to death with a knife during an argument.

The incident reportedly took place at about 6.15 pm on Friday on the Direct Labour Agency Road, Asaba.

Sources said when the officer slumped, those around felt he had died and instantly lynched the two attackers.


