

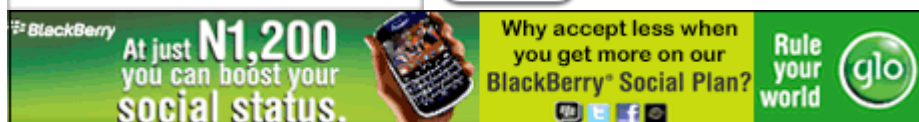

Four die, seven injured in Ogun road crashes

No fewer than four persons were killed on Thursday while seven others sustained serious injuries in three separate road crashes in Ijebu Ode and Ijebu East Local Government areas of Ogun State.

THE PUNCH learnt that the accidents were caused by recklessness and overspeeding by the drivers.

An eyewitness said the first accident occurred at Yatoyo, Benin-Ore Expressway in Ijebu-East where four passengers died following a head-on collision between a Volvo truck with number plate Lagos XZ 185 AGL and a Benz truck with number plate Lagos XC 228 AGD.

The second accident involved a fuel tanker with number plate Lagos XH 993 USL and a Mercedes Benz car marked Lagos BD 658 BGE.

The second crash took place at Mobalufon in Ijebu Ode, leaving three people critically injured.

Sources said the third accident, in which four people were severely wounded, occurred at Odogbolu area of the Sagamu–Benin Expressway.

The Ijebu Ode Unit Commander of the state-owned Traffic Compliance and Enforcement Agency, Mr. Adekunle Ajibade, confirmed the accidents.

According to him, the third accident was caused by armed robbers who struck along the road. He explained that while trying to escape from the bandits, the two cars collided.

He added that all the injured persons had been taken to the

General Hospital, Ijebu Ode for medical attention. Ajibade urged road users to abide by traffic rules and regulation in order to prevent accidents.

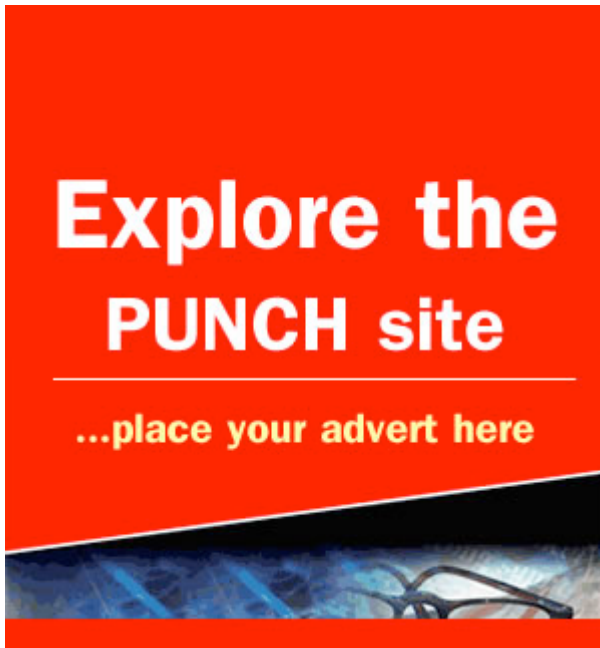
