Truck crushes okada riders, others in Ondo

At least five persons, including two brothers, were crushed to death when a trailer driver lost control of the vehicle on Sunday morning on the Ikare-Okeagbe Road in front of the Akoko Anglican Diocese Cemetery.

Our correspondent learnt that three young men died on the spot while two others, who were rushed to a hospital, died later.

The accident involved a lorry with Lagos State number plate XC 476 GGE and three commercial motorcycles.

According to eyewitnesses, the deceased included an Igbo trader at the Osele Market, Ikare, known as Ebuka, his brother, and an Okada rider known as Taye.

An eyewitness said, "He approached a T-Junction on high speed and ran over the commercial motorcycles and their riders."

The Police Public Relations Officer, Mr. Aremu Adeniran, confirmed the development, saying the driver was careless to have run into a junction and hit three commercial motorcycles.

Adeniran said, "The tanker driver was very careless. He knew that the brakes of his vehicle were bad and he still went ahead and drove the truck."

He added that three persons, including two brothers, died on the spot while the two others died in the hospital.

Also, suspected cultists besieged Epinmi Akoko, killed a man known as Niyi Arohunmolase and dumped his mutilated body behind the health centre in the town on Saturday.

Arohunmolase, son of a popular teacher, was said to have been invited by a friend for a video coverage job in the town.

He left but never returned. His remains were found dumped behind the health centre where his mother works.

The friend who invited him for the video coverage job has been arrested and he is helping the police in their investigation into the murder.
