Maiduguri, Borno State. Four men were said to have stormed the Ahoada end of the East-West Road

in an ash-coloured Toyota saloon car and opened fire on the three policemen at their duty post.

While they succeeded in killing two, one, who sustained gunshot injury, managed to escape.

The incident, which happened around 5.30pm, attracted sympathisers

Eze was arraigned in March 2010 on nine counts of conspiracy, obtaining by false pretence, forgery and altering.

The Rivers State Police Commissioner, Mohammed Indabawa, confirmed the incident, but added that he had vet to get the details of what happened.

Meanwhile, Borno State Commissioner of Police. Alhaji Bala Hassan, said in a statement that the gunmen attacked the Benisheikh police station around 7pm but were repelled by policemen on duty. "When the situation

became tense. reinforcement was sought from the crack unit close bv.

"The attackers were repelled but they used a rocket launcher to attack the building, which destroyed part of the structure." Hassan said.

The commissioner. however, said the attackers escaped after falling to the superior power of the police team.

"Unfortunately, one civilian was killed after the encounter. He must have been killed in the crossfire," Hassan said.
