JTF kills four suspected terrorists in Kano

TOUR suspected terrorists were killed on Saturday at the Janblock quarters in Gwale Local Government Area of Kano State during a raid on their hideout by operatives of the Joint Special Task Force.

Sources told SUNDAY PUNCH that the JTF had raided a house, which served as the operational base of the terrorists on the outskirts of the Kano city along Gwarzo Road, near Bayero University, Kano Old Campus.

It was learnt that the security operatives uncovered

a vehicle believed to have been primed for a suicide mission.

By the time the operation ended, the JTF operatives recovered large cache of arms and ammunition, including high capacity explosives.

Spokesman for the JTF, Lt. Ikedichi Iweoha confirmed the incident.

He said, "A dawn raid was carried out by the task force at the early hours of yesterday, resulting in a gun duel. At the end of which four suspected terrorists were killed in their hideout, located at Jan-block."
