Police killing

SOME aggrieved relatives of a middle-aged man, Mr. Idowu Adesokan, allegedly shot by a policeman at a checkpoint at Odo Ana-Arapaja area of Ibadan on Tuesday took to the streets in protest against the killing.

The protesters allegedly brought the corpse of the deceased to the Office of the Governor in a car marked OYO JJJ 658 AP.

The elder brother of the deceased, Kehinde, who spoke with journalists, said his brother was shot and killed in his car by a policeman (name not known).

Contrary to the claim by the protesters, the Police Public Relations Officer, Mr. Ayandele Lanade, a Deputy Superintendent of Police, said "the allegation that the deceased was shot by a police was not established by the statement of the only passenger in the car."
