Four die in Calabar auto crash

POUR persons were reportedly killed in an auto crash on the outskirts of Calabar, Cross River

State, on Saturday.

An eyewitness said the four occupants of an Audi Salon with number plate

XA635 BRA including the driver died on the spot at about 11am when the accident occurred.

According to him, the car, (taxi), which was heading towards Calabar, ran on to a stationary trailer loaded with cement.

It was learnt that the Federal Road Safety Corps

officials, who arrived at the scene shortly after the accident, struggled to remove the victims who were trapped in the vehicle.

The state Police Public Relations Officer, Mr. Hogan Bassey, however said

only one person died.

When told that the state owned radio station, Cross River Broadcasting Corporation had reported that four persons died in the

accident, the PPRO said the

other three might have died

on their way to hospital.

But the Sector
Commander of the Federal

Commander of the Federal Road Safety Corps in Cross River State, Mr. Yusuff Salami, said two persons died on the spot while two other who sustained serious injuries were rushed to a

near-by hospital.

Heattributed the accident to a dangerous driving by the taxi driver, adding that the situation would have

been averted if the driver

was more careful.

Meanwhile the Director
General of Cross River State
Emergency Management

Agency Mr. Vincent Aquah.

described the accident as

"disheartening".

Aquah advised motorists to be cautious on the road to avoid accidents that could maim or cause loss of lives.
