

18 die in Edo crash

FIGHTEEN persons
were reportedly killed
in a multiple vehicle
accident that occurred on
the Benin-Ore Expressway
on Thursday morning.

An eyewitness said the vehicles involved in the accident included a truck carrying beverage drinks, another one laden with sand, and a fully loaded 18-seater commercial bus.

The eyewitness said the beverage truck driver lost control of the vehicle before it veered off its lane, hitting the sand truck.

The bus, which was at top speed behind the sand truck, ran into the trucks.

Fifteen of the passengers in the bus and three persons in the sand truck reportedly died from the accident; while three others sustained various degrees of injury.

Many of the victims reportedly died on their

way to the hospital

The Public Relations
Officer of the Federal Road
Safety Corps, John Aniedi,
however, said six persons
died in the accident
while others, severely
injured, were taken to
the commission's clinic,

for treatment.

Aniedi, however, said he had yet to get an update on the casualty figure.
