An unidentified person was burnt beyond recognition while three others were injured in a road accident on the Ilesha-Akure-Owo Expressway on Monday night.

The accident, which occurred around 10pm, involved a loaded J5 Peugeot bus and a Honda Accord saloon car, both of which got burnt completely.

According to eyewitnesses, both vehicles had a head-on collision.

It was gathered that after the collision, the bus somersaulted and burst into flames, while the fire extended to the car after a few

minutes.

The driver of the bus and one passenger managed to escape, while the last person, whose identity has yet to be known, died.

When men of the Ondo State Fire Service arrived the scene, youths barred them from coming down.

They said the firefighters came late despite several distressed calls put across to them when the fire started.

The injured were later taken to the state Specialist Hospital in Akure.

Head of Operations of Federal Road Safety Corps in the state, Mr. Sunday Ajayi, who confirmed the incident, appealed to the motorists to always drive carefully and adhere to traffic rules and regulation.
