## Robbers killed

The Oyo State Police Command on Friday paraded the corpses of four armed robbers killed in separate gun battles.

The state Commissioner of Police, Mohammed Indabawa, told newsmen in Ibadan that while one of them was killed in an attempt to evade security post around Seko near Dominion University, Lagos-Ibadan Expressway on Friday, the three others were killed while trying to escape with a stolen car.

Indabawa said the three robbers snatched a Honda Accord car with Lagos number plate TD 206 AAA from one Adeniran Ademola around Akobo police station in Ibadan at gun point and headed towards Oyo road. A manhunt was launched for the robbers with the help of one Kwara Azare, a hunter in the area.

Realising that they were being trailed, the robbers veered off the road to Alaaka and decided to engage the police in gun battle.

The police subsequently recovered the car after injuring the robbers. They later died as a result of the injuries they sustained in the gun duel with the police.

An AK 47 rifle, one double barrel locally made pistol, one single barrel locally made shot-gun, 101 rounds of live ammunition, nine rounds of live cartridges, eight mobile phones, one laptop and the sum of N17,170 were also recovered from the scene.

The robber who was killed at Seko was said to have stolen a Toyota Camry car with Lagos number plate ST 57 AAA, which belongs to Omowunmi Abubakar of Yinusa Balogun bus stop Okota palace, Lagos.
