

The accused, who resides at 6, Ken Narebor Street, Eputu Town in Ibeju-Lekki, Lagos, is facing a two-count of reckless driving and manslaughter.

The prosecutor, Inspector Ignatus Okeke, said the accused committed the offences on April 5, 2014 on Abijo Highway in Ibeju-Lekki.

Okeke alleged that the accused drove her vehicle recklessly and knocked down one Sulaiman Ahmed.

"The victim was rushed to a nearby hospital, where he was confirmed dead."

He said the offences contravened Sections 18 (1) and 20 (1) of the Lagos State Road Traffic Law, 2012.

In her ruling, the Magistrate, Mrs. Salama Matepo, granted the woman bail in the sum of N200, 000 with two sureties in like sum and adjourned the case to May 5, 2014.
