① SEVEN persons were on Tuesday killed by the infamous Boko Haram sect during the funeral ceremony of the 20 killed a day earlier by the same sect in Sabon Gari, Damboa Local Government Area of Borno State.

 The insurgents also laid a siege to Huyim village in Askira-Uba Local Government Area of the state, and killed nine persons.

It will be recalled that two days ago, some suspected terrorists group had attacked neighbouring Mandafuma village in Biu Local Government Area

of the state, injuring one person, while property worth millions of naira was destroyed.

In what seems like a series of attacks on the southern part of the state, a main bridge linking Maiduguri- Damboa- Madafuma- Biu road was blown off by terrorists at the weekend.

Sources said the latest attack which took place at about 6pm on Tuesday, left about 20 innocent people dead, while seven others were killed, on Wednesday morning.

It was gathered that the terrorists, who had retreated on Tuesday, regrouped and launched another attack on Sabon Gari, killing those that had gone to the cemetery to bury the dead.
