No fewer than seven persons died in an auto crash at the Igbara Oke axis of the Ilesha-Akure expressway on Tuesday.

The accident, which occurred in Ifedore Local Government Area of Ondo State, involved a truck and a Toyota space wagon.

The number plate of the truck was ALK 04 XA while that of the wagon was Lagos KRD 711 AG.

It was gathered that the wagon was heading towards Akure from Lagos.

According to an eyewitness, the driver of truck loaded with cement lost control, leading to a collision with the wagon.

The driver of the wagon identified as Sunday Efo and six other occupants died in the process while the truck driver sustained injuries.

The eyewitness added that some residents of the area and other commercial drivers made unsuccessful efforts to save the lives of the victims.

The Head of Operations, Federal Road Safety Corps, Ondo State, Mr. Adeleye Adegboyega, who confirmed the incident, said the dead had been deposited at the morgue of the State Specialist Hospital, Akure, while the injured were taken to the same hospital for treatment.

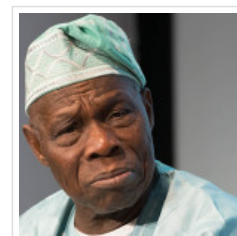
