demanded N5,000.

"Bassey is my lover. We have been dating for two years. On the day of her death, we had three rounds of sex. I can't really say if I was tempted by the devil to kill her.

"When she refused to collect the N1,000 that I gave her, we started quarrelling and it led to a fight. I brought out a sharp kitchen knife and stabbed her.

"After stabbing her, she screamed and neighbours broke into my room. They saw her on the ground in a pool

of blood. She later died," he said.

According to him, it was his neighbours that called the policemen that arrested him.

"I regret my actions, I wish I did not kill her," he said.

Speaking on the breakthrough of the command in the past few weeks, which included the arrest of over 15 suspects, the state Commissioner of Police, Fadairo, said his men were determined to stamp out criminals, kidnappers and murderers out of the state.

Fadairo said that the suspects would be in police custody until the strike embarked on by Judiciary Staff Union of Nigeria was called off.

He appealed to the association to dialogue with the state government to resolve the strike, adding that there were too many suspects in police net waiting to be charged to court.
