A woman, Wunmi Omowa, has allegedly stabbed her police husband, Israel, to death during a free-for-all at the Olu Foam area of Akure, Ondo State.

A police source said the couple had a misunderstanding which degenerated into a free-for-all, adding that the inspector's wife rushed to the kitchen and returned with a knife which he used to stab her husband in the neck.

The Police Public Relations Officer, Mr. Femi Joseph, explained that the deceased died as a result of loss of blood

Joseph said the late cop was a member of the Fast Strike Squad in the state.

The PPRO said, "We have commenced investigation into the death, while the suspect has been arrested."
