The Monday accident involved a Mazda car with number plate, AAA 840 BS, and a Pathfinder with number plate, BDG 587 DD.

Our correspondent gathered that the victims of the crash were the two male occupants of the Mazda car.

The Public Relations Officer, Ogun State Traffic Compliance and Enforcement Agency, Babatunde Akinbiyi, said the driver of the

Mazda car, who was travelling outward Abeokuta, lost control of the vehicle when a young girl suddenly crossed the road.

Akinbiyi said, "In a bid not to kill the girl, the driver swerved and the car crossed over to the opposite

lane. It had a head-on collision with the oncoming Pathfinder. The two male occupants of the Mazda car died instantly."

He added that the occupants of the Pathfinder – a male and a female – sustained injuries and were rushed to the Ifo General Hospital.
