

Gunmen invade Rivers community, kill six

Six persons have been killed in Ibaa community of Emohua Local Government Area of Rivers State by suspected cultists.

The PUNCH learnt that gunmen suspected to be members of Greenlanders cult had invaded the community on Sunday following a clash for supremacy in the area.

A reliable source told our correspondent that the attack was reprisal against rival cult, the Icelanders and that those killed were members of Icelanders.

Prince Nyenke, Dirinna, Kpomasiruchi, ThankGod were among the six people that were killed, the source said.

The source, who spoke anonymously, said the invaders operated freely in the community without interruption.

It was gathered that the police post situated in the community had been closed since the shootout on Sunday night.
