DSS parades suspected killers of ABSU students

THE Abia State command of the Department of State Services has arrested four suspects believed to be involved in the murder of three students of the Abia State University, Uturu on March 12, 2015.

The victims, who were allegedly beheaded were Ebuka Nwaigbo and Samuel Ethelbert Chuka. Their attackers used their heads as goalpost in a playing ground in front of the school gate. The suspects paraded the DSS on Thursday are Chikezie Macdonald (a.k.a Walking Dutch) 21; Chidozie Obi (Small Boy) 22; Chukwuemeka Awom (a.k.a Archangel) 25; and Chigizie Francis Eberendu, 23 (a.k.a Star Boy).

A statement made available to journalists in Umuahia, the state capital, by the DSS Director, Mr. Korede Kamoru, stated that the suspects were arrested in liaison with the authorities of the Michael Okpara University of Agriculture, Umudike near Umuahia where Macdonald is studying Microbiology.

The statement partly read, "The suspects confessed to the crime with Macdonald who is the current Capon of *Burkina Faso Cult* in MOUAU admitting that he was part of the planning of the attack at a hotel along Ikot- Ekpene Road in Umuahia.

"He promised to supply the guns to be used for the attack and also promised to donate N6,000, but only succeeded in supplying the gun, but did not take part in the attack.

"Awom, however, said

the attack was a reprisal meant to avenge the death of Collins Agwu Kalu (a.k.a Biggy) a 400-Level student of Microbiology in ABSU, who was the leader of the *Burkina Faso Cult* in the university who was allegedly killed by Maphite members on the February 22, 2016.

"He said he was part of the planning of attack and played a role of the gatekeeper at the Chido Lodge Uturu during the attack to alert his men if security agents were approaching the venue.

"Obi, who happens to be an indigene of Ututu although not a student deals in used clothes in Port Harcourt, Rivers State, said he partook in the shooting and actual beheading of their victims. "He also said he and Awon actually partook in the dropping of the severed heads at the school gate."
