

Family loses third child to Ogun petrol fire

Iyanuoluwa, one of the surviving children of the Oluwasegun family whose bungalow was gutted by fire in Ogun State, is dead.

The death of Iyanuoluwa makes it three deaths in a family of four children.

PUNCH Metro had reported that a set of twins was burnt to death on Tuesday, October 11, in a fire incident in Goun community, in the Magboro area of Ogun State.

Our correspondent had reported that the family was preparing to have dinner when the fire started.

While the twins were killed, other members of the family sustained different degrees of burns.

A relative of the victims, Pastor Moses Igbinadolor, told our correspondent that Iyanuoluwa had also died.

Igbinadolor said Abosede and her husband, Aina, had yet to be informed of the loss of their three children.

He said, "The girl also died around 11am last Monday. The doctor told us that she sustained 65 degree burns and that was why she could not make it.

"The parents are also in critical condition and are not aware that the twins and Iyanuoluwa are dead.

"We desperately need the help and support of members of the public for the family, or the two parents may also lose their lives."
