Four die, others injured in Jigawa's road crash

THE police in Jigawa State on Tuesday said four persons died in a road crash involving a Toyota bus, marked FKY 943 XA, on the Huguma-Dutse Road.

The Police Public Relations Officer in the command, Abdu Jinjiri, told newsmen in Dutse, the state capital, that the crash occurred at about 8pm on Monday.

Jinjiri, a Superintendent of Police, explained that the accident happened when the driver of the bus lost control at Kudai Buji village in the Dutse Local Government Area of the state.

He added that the bus had 28 passengers at the time of the crash, consisting of 18 females and 10 males from Kwayakusar in Borno State.

The PPRO said three of the victims died on the spot, while another passenger died later at the Rasheed Shekoni Specialist Hospital, Dutse.

According to him, the rest of the passengers sustained varying degrees of injuries and were receiving treatment at the same hospital.

Jinjiri advised motorists to desist from speeding and overloading under whatever circumstances.
