

Two killed in Lagos filling station

Two persons have been killed at a filling station at Afolabi bus stop, Lasu-Iyana Iba Road, Lagos State.

PUNCH Metro learnt that the victims were attacked at Sungaz Petrol Station, in the early hours of Sunday.

Although the names of the victims had yet to be ascertained, they were said to have hailed from the northern part of the country.

A resident of the area, who spoke on condition of anonymity, said the men were robbed and killed afterwards.

He said, “They were killed around 1am today (Sunday). Hausas in the community are demanding justice over the death of their brothers. Policemen from the Igando division are on the ground.”

The Lagos State Police Public Relations Officer, ASP Olarinde Famous-Cole, said a suspect had been arrested in connection with the killing.

He said, “We are investigating a murder case because nothing was stolen. We have made an arrest that can lead to why it happened.

“We have invited the security guards that were on duty. The victims were two males from the northern part of the country. We are still trying to get more facts, but there is nothing linking it to robbery or assassination.”
