# Flood kills two-year-old baby in Jos

The corpse of a two-year-old boy suspected to have been killed by flood has been found in the Yan Shanu area of the Jos North Local Government Area of Plateau State.

The state police command on Tuesday added that the corpse had been deposited in the mortuary of the University of Jos Teaching Hospital.

The Public Relations Officer for the state command, Matthias Tyopev, an Assistant Superintendent of Police, confirmed the discovery.

He called on members of the public looking for a male child of that age to contact JUTH for details.

Tyopev said, “The two-year-old boy was found at Yan Shanu, Nassarawa Gwong, on July 6, 2017. Members of the public looking for a two-year-old male child are advised to contact the University of Jos Teaching Hospital mortuary for identification.”

He also advised parents and guardians to monitor their children and wards.

The police spokesman urged vehicle owners in the state to take appropriate security measures in safeguarding their vehicles.

“Vehicles should be secured with pedal or steering locks in addition to installing tracking devices to reduce incidence of car theft and snatching,” he added.
