

## One dies, five injured in Ogun auto crash

**A** driver of a Toyota Hiace commercial bus has died, while five others were injured on Tuesday at the Redemption Camp end of the Lagos-Ibadan Expressway.

The accident was said to have occurred after the bus rammed into a stationary crane allegedly parked by the roadside.

The bus, according to information gathered by our correspondent, was travelling to Lagos when the incident occurred.

The Public Relations Officer, Ogun State Traffic Compliance and Enforcement Corps, Babatunde Akinbiyi, said the bus was conveying 14 passengers, adding that it was coming from Kano State and heading for Lagos.

He said it was only the driver of the commercial bus with number plate, DRZ 360 XA, who died in the accident.

He said, "The commercial bus was coming from Kano

State before it ran into a faulty crane parked by the roadside around the Redemption Camp along the Lagos-Ibadan Expressway.

"The TRACE operatives at the scene of the accident reported that only the driver of the bus died, while five others, among the 14 passengers, sustained injuries.

"The auto crash was caused by speeding on the part of the driver, who lost control, and rammed the bus into the crane."

He said the corpse had been taken to a private mortuary in Sagamu, while the persons that sustained injuries were receiving treatment in an undisclosed hospital.
