

Four die in Ogun crashes

Four persons reportedly died while 19 others were injured in two separate auto accidents that occurred on Friday night and Saturday morning in Ogun State.

In the first accident, a Toyota Corolla, with 12 passengers, was reported to have plunged into the Ososa River, while heading to Ijebu Ode.

Traffic report indicated that the car was carrying one male, four females and seven children.

Ten of them were however rescued while two others, one male adult and a little girl died.

According to statistics from the state command of the Federal Road Safety Corps and the Ogun State Traffic Compliance and Enforcement Corps, four female adults and six children were injured.

The Sector Commander, FRSC, Clement Oladele, said the corpses of the victims had been deposited in the mortuary at the State General Hospital, Ijebu Ode, while the injured were receiving treatment at the same hospital.

He said loss of control occasioned by excessive speeding was responsible for the accident.
