A middle-aged man, Gbenga Babatunde, has reportedly collapsed and died during an argument at a drinking joint in Ondo town, Ondo State.

He said, "It was a very unfortunate incident. The man slumped and died when he was drinking at the joint but his family had come to us that they were not interested in taking any legal action on the matter and we have released the corpse to them."
