

Nonagenarian's killers remanded

A magistrate court sitting in Akure, Ondo State has ordered the remand of two persons, Akpan Joseph and Isah Ajayi, in prison custody for allegedly killing a 90-year-old man in Ajana camp, Owo Local Government Area of the state.

The two accused and some others, who had reportedly fled the community, were arrested last month by the state police command for allegedly killing the old man, identified as Usman Dabioku.

They were arraigned on a two-count charge of conspiracy and murder.

In her ruling, the magistrate, Mrs. Victoria Bob-Manuel, ordered that the accused be remanded in prison custody pending the outcome of the legal advice from the office of the DPP, while the case was adjourned to July 24.
