

Court remands herdsman for allegedly killing brother

An Ilorin Magistrate's Court in Kwara State on Friday ordered that a herdsman, Sule Sheu, be remanded in the Federal Medium Security Prison for allegedly killing his brother, Mohammed.

Magistrate Folake Olokoyo gave the order as the accused person's plea could not be taken after he was charged with culpable homicide.

Earlier, the prosecutor, Sgt. Thomas Adebayo, told the court that the accused was arrested following a report by his uncle; Nabo Abubakar, at the Divisional Police Headquarters, Afon.

Adebayo said that the complainant alleged that the accused person beat up the deceased with a stick and inflicted deep cuts on him.

The prosecutor said the offence, contravened the provisions of

Section 221 of the Penal Code Law. Olokoyo adjourned the case until December 3 for further mention.
