

Four workers nabbed in Lagos for foreigner's death

Four domestic workers of an Indian national, Ram Kishan Sharma, who lived on Glory Estate, Shagamu Road, Ikorodu area of Lagos, have been arrested in connection with Sharma's death.

Our correspondent learnt that Sharma, 55, worked with a manufacturing firm in Ogiyo, Ogun State.

He was reportedly found dead in his apartment on December 30, 2018 with a head injury while a bloodstained iron rod was recovered at the scene.

The Lagos PPRO, Chike Oti, said the incident was reported at the Sagamu Road Police Station.

Oti said, "It was reported to the police that one Ram Kishan Sharma, aged 55, an Indian and staff member of Agriex Nigeria Limited in Ogiyo, Ogun State, was found dead in his apartment. Based on the report, a team of homicide detectives was mobilised to the scene.

"On arrival, the team met the deceased with a head injury while a bloodstained short iron rod, reasonably suspected to have been used to hit him, was recovered. His corpse was evacuated to the Ikorodu General Hospital morgue for autopsy.

"Meanwhile, four servants of the deceased – the cook, security man and two drivers have been arrested. The command will leave no stone unturned to resolve the killing and bring the perpetrator(s) to justice."
