injury. Akinbiyi said those injured in the crash had been receiving treatment at Federal Medical Centre, Idi-Aba , Abeokuta, General Hospital, Ijaiye, and Joseph /Christianah Hospital, Oke-Ilewo, all in Abeokuta.
