SEVEN people on Tuesday lost their lives as a truck in which they were travelling plunged into a river at Kotonkarfe community on the Lokoja-Abuja highway.

According to him, both the injured and dead were taken to the Federal Medical Centre and the Kogi State Specialist Hospital in Lokoja.

Abe said speeding was the immediate cause of the accident.
