

Four beheaded, three killed in fresh Rivers cult war

There are indications that seven persons were feared killed on Saturday as cultists struck again in some parts of Rivers State.

The armed cult members continued their terror in Ikwerre, Obio/Akpor, Emohua and the Port Harcourt Local Government Areas of the state.

Four persons were said to have been beheaded in Omuoko, Aluu in the Ikwerre LGA and three persons were killed in the Port Harcourt, Obio/Akpor and Emohua LGAs. Those beheaded were identified as Rhino, Justice Azubuike, Nwobueze Woke and another whose name couldn't be ascertained as of press time.

One of the victims, Azubuike, was said to have recently gained admission to the Ignatius Ajuru University of Education, Port Harcourt.
