Flood kills four, submerges 40 houses in Nasarawa

About four people reportedly lost their lives to flooding during the early hours of Thursday at various communities in four local government areas of Nasarawa State, while over 40 houses were said to have been destroyed.

One of the areas affected by the flood includes Tudun Amba River area of the Lafia Local Government Area of the state when the bridge connecting Doma Local Government Area of the state was submerged by the flood.

Tudun Amba River bridge where the incident occurred, connected workers village, 500 housing units, Doma town and some villages.

Investigation indicated that in Sabon Gari area of Doma town, the headquarters of Doma Local Government Area, over seven houses were affected by the flooding, other properties were destroyed but no life was lost.
