

38 die in Gombe road accidents

The Federal Roads Safety Corps in Gombe State says no fewer than 151 road accidents occurred in the state from September to December last year.

According to the FRSC Sector Commandant in the state Godwin Omiko, 38 people lost their lives while 397 sustained varying degrees of injury.

Omiko warned motorists to drive with care to avoid accidents.

He said the corps would continue to create awareness of how to avoid road accidents.

The FRSC chief told community leaders, traditional leaders and religious leaders to help the body to sensitise their people about the need to obey traffic rules.
