## Suspected assassins kill another PDP member in Delta

Suspected assassins have killed a member of the Peoples Democratic Party in the Ethiope East Local Government Area of Delta State, Mr Ovie Iroro.

The incident happened barely one week after the party's ward chairman at Olomu in the Ughelli South Local Government Area, Mr Paul Onomuakpokpo, was also shot dead by unknown gunmen.

Iroro, who was in his early 30s, was reportedly killed at his residence in the university community of Abraka at about 10pm on Wednesday night.

Sources said the killers invaded his home and dragged him to a nearby bush where

they murdered him.

Sources within the community claimed that the deceased might have been killed over

his alleged disagreement with suspected Internet fraudsters in the area.

Multiple sources in the area, including the Chairman of Ethiope East LGA, Chief

Faith Majemite, confirmed the killing.

The Delta State Commissioner of Police, Hafiz Inuwa, told journalists that Iroro was

a suspected cultist and fraudster.

Inuwa, in a telephone interview, added that the police were investigating the murder.

He said, "He was a cultist and a fraudster. The police division (Abraka) had arrested

him several times.

"A crime was committed and we are after the perpetrators. It is after we have

arrested them that we will be able to know if it is their dubious activities that made

them to kill him."
