Pupil feared dead in Ibadan cult clash

A yet-to-be-identified pupil of IMG Grammar School, Ibadan, Oyo State, was on Wednesday feared dead while other pupils sustained injuries during a clash between pupils of the school and those of Oke-Bola Comprehensive High School, Ibadan.

The two schools are situated in the same neighbourhood.

The pupils of the two schools, who were involved in the clash, are suspected to be members of rival cults engaged in supremacy war.

A lawyer, who spoke on condition of anonymity, said the pupils of the two schools regularly engaged in bloody fight.

He said, "On Wednesday, the pupils clashed as usual at about 1pm. By the time the attack was over, over 10 vehicles were vandalised."

The Police Public Relations Officer in Oyo State, Olugbenga Fadeyi; and the Commissioner for Education, Olasunkanmi Olaleye, were unavailable for comments.
