UNMEN, on Tuesday. kidnapped four people on the Kabba-Auga Akoko Expressway in the Akoko North-East Local Government Area of Oudo

One of the victims is a Captain of the Nigerian Army. identified as D. Gana, who was said to be coming from Abuja with the other victims when the incident happened. According to a source, the

hoodlums stopped the vehicle conveying the victims and dragged them into the bush and from there marched them to an unknown destination.

The source explained that the hoodlums did not pick any item belonging to the victims from the vehicle, but left the doors open.

It was, however, gathered that the abductors had contacted the families of the victims to demand N20m for their release.

A source said immediately the police at the Ikare Akoko Division got information about the incident, they proceeded to the scene but met only the abandoned vehicle.

It was learnt that men of the 32 Artillery Brigade, Nigerian Army, Akure, mobilised to the area to comb the bush with a view to rescuing the victims and apprehending

"We have begun intensive investigation into the incident and we want to enjoin anybody with useful information that can lead to the arrest of the criminals to forward same to the police for onward action." Ikoro stated

Also, the Public Relations Officer of the 32 Artillery Brigade, Nigerian Army, Akure, Captain Avorinde Omojokun, simply said. "We are still on the matter."
