Student, 25, hacked to death in Nasarawa

A 25-year-old student of the College of Health Science and Technology, Keffi, Nasarawa State, Yusuf Adi, has reportedly been hacked to death at Ugah, in Lafia, the state capital.

A community leader, Mr Musa Saidu, who confirmed the incident to *PUNCH Metro*, said Adi was attacked by one Rabiun Omiya, while he was sleeping.

“Operatives of the Special Anti-Robbery Squad came and apprehended two persons in connection with the crime in Ugah town,” Saidu stated.

He alleged that Omiya dealt machete blows to Adi's head and injured his younger brother, adding that the victim lost much blood and died.

Saidu said the assailant was on the run, but the incident had been reported to the Area 'C' Police Division.

The Police Public Relations Officer in the state, ASP Ramhan Nansel, who confirmed the incident to our correspondent on Thursday, said the command was on the trail of the suspect to facilitate his arrest.
