Two killed in Osun crash

Two persons, on Monday, lost their lives in a crash that occurred on the Ibokun Road, Osogbo, Osun State.

The crash, which occurred around 1.50pm, led to gridlock on the road as men of the Federal Road Safety Corps battled to clear the scene and restore free flow of traffic.

A source at the scene, who simply identified himself as Azeez, told PUNCH Metro that a Mack truck that suffered a brake failure rammed into a Honda Element car and a Bajaj motorcycle, leaving two persons dead on the spot.

"The two deceased persons were on the motorcycle when the accident occurred and they died on the spot," Azeez stated.

When contacted, the Osun Sector Public Education Officer, FRSC, Agnes Ogungbemi, confirmed that two lives were

lost in the accident.

She stated that the corpses had been deposited in the morgue of the Ladoke Akintola University of Technology Teaching Hospital, Osogbo.

"The accident must have been caused by brake failure. Men of the Federal Road Safety Corps moved in immediately the crash occurred and cleared the scene," Ogungbemi added.
